A Parental Vision Screening Checklist**



WHAT IS C B4 3

A checklist completed by a parent that asks about birth and health risk factors, parent observations, and child behaviors.

The checklist is under development to test a new way to screen children under the age of 3 years of age for eye problems.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

A parent with a child less than 3 years of age

WHAT WILL HAPPEN

You will be asked to complete a checklist about your child's behaviors & health risk factors.

You will be asked to provide demographic and contact information for you and your child.

Your child will have a complete eye exam by a pediatric optometrist and you will be informed of the results.
